ADINA HOME-START



2024 represented a true revival of the Home-Start program. After the interviews and selection process within the specific recruiting campaign, 9 new volunteers were trained and joined the Home-Start Romania volunteer team.

The weekly home visits, run from 1st of May to 30th of October, supported 14 vulnerable families from Simnicu de Sus, Goiesti and Fărcas communes providing practical and emotional support, strengthening family bonds, preventing problems that could negatively impact children's development, and helping children to learn and develop by playing.



ADINA AFTERSCHOOL



The activities run in partnership with Leşile school and Goieşti school took place in 4 different locations – Leşile, Goieşti, Țandăra, Piorești and were approved by the County School Inspectorate within the "School After School" projects.

Children with poor family backgrounds, from grades I-IV, received educational support, participated in extracurricular activities supported by volunteer teachers.

The program has had a significant impact on children, parents, and teachers, contributing to improved school performance, the development of social skills, and supporting families in managing the time dedicated to education but also increasing the awareness for a clean environment and the importance of recycling.











ADINA AFTERSCHOOL

ADINA HOME



Designed for children from grades V-VIII from Simnicu de Sus and Goiesti communities, the program follows the same concept as the afterschool program.

The activities carried out three times a week in Adina Home consisted of homework, tutoring classes, crafting workshops, decoration making, painting and coloring, outdoor and indoor games and activities, board games, improving digital skills within Code Kids and First Lego League specific activities.

In 2024, 4 pupils from Adina Home program graduated 8th grade, 2 of them becoming Educational program beneficiaries and the other 2 being enrolled in V13 Program.

ADINA EDUCATIONAL



The 29 high school students, 1 vocational school student, and 6 university students received material support for completing their homework and school projects, having the opportunity to use all the office equipment in the study room at Adina Home, as well as a financial allowance of 300 lei/month to cover part of their school expenses (bus pass, school supplies, etc.), along with access to a suitable study space where they could work on assignments, projects, and other essential tasks for their academic progress. They also took part in various activities within the Adina Home and V13 Programs and workshops, being a real support, while strengthening group relationships and promoting mutual support among participants.








The Empo ladies are seen as a resource for the organization and their contribution in different activities in Adina Home is irreplaceable and very high appreciate by the staff and Board. From taking care of the lavander field and Adina Home green spaces, to sewing lavander bags, creating lavander soap, lavender floral water, scented candles, learning how to prepare mocktails, participating to Healthy food training course, The EMPO program was more than just a program, was a chance for continuous learning.

15 Empo ladies stepped out of their comfort zone daring to venture beyond the boundaries of what was safe and familiar until now by being enrolled in formal training 10 of them graduating cook courses and 5 tailoring courses.



The project "We build people, we build communities!" implemented in the period 08.01.2024 - 31.01.2025 for which Adina Stiftelsen Foundation has received a GlobalGiving Grant, in partnership with Cummins Generator Technologies Romania







- Contributed to strengthening the ability to respond to the child's developmental needs of 31 parents;
- Promoted the increase in the participation of 62 vulnerable children in afterschool activities and the improvement of school performance;
- Promoted the increase in the participation of 59 vulnerable children in socio-educational
 activities aimed at facilitating the transition from being a pupil in the rural environment to
 being a high school student in the urban environment;
- Contributed to the improvement and development of the skills necessary to achieve tertiary / vocational education of 16 youngsters;
- Supported the active participation 21 women by providing activities aimed at empowering and developing the attitudes and skills needed as employees and active members in the community;
- Provided access to cook training courses for 10 women and tailoring training courses for 5 women;
- Promoted mindset changes and joint efforts for positive change in local communities.




KEY FIGURES 2024

Our team participated in training courses, conferences, and experience exchanges to improve the services offered and share its competence.

The two social workers of the foundation, Mihaela Ruiu and Alisa Bulugean graduated the Social Services Manager training course supported by Concordia Academy and authorized by Minister of Labor and Social Protection in Romania.

Since December 2024 within the frame of new legislative provisions, both of them are enrolled in the mandatory professional supervision program supported by National College of Social Workers in Romania.

Georgiana Cocie attended the Circle of Security training course as part of a project initiated and developed by Fundatia Noi Orizonturi - The project is integrated in the Discussions from the heart campaign and is supported by Pepco Romania and is now set to promote meetings for parents in 2025.
